

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


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What is University College?

University College offers an educational program designed to help international students who are admitted to Korea University's undergraduate programs successfully adapt to university life by systematically strengthening their foundational academic, linguistic, and cultural competencies during their first year of study.

After completing the one-year foundational curriculum, students choose a major that aligns with their interests and aptitudes. Upon advancing to their second year, they enter one of 46 departments/divisions in areas such as the humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, engineering, and the arts.

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One-Year Foundational Curriculum



Required General Education
